Brandon Pyramidal Aborvitae (Thuja occidentalis 'Brandon')

Medium growing. Height 12-15', 3-4' wide. Narrow cone shaped. Bright green foliage. Withstands harsh conditions. *Excellent screen or hedge*.

Little Giant Arbovitae (Thuja occidantalis 'Little Giant')

Slow growing. Height 6', 6' wide. Globe shaped. Has rich green foliage.

Skyrocket Juniper (Juniperus virginiana 'Skyrocket')

Medium to fast growth. Height 20', 2-3' wide. Very narrow form. Silver-blue gray foliage.



Border Pine (Pinus strobiformus)

Medium growth. Height 35-40'. Pyramidal form. Long, dark bluish-green foliage. Has many of the characteristics of the White Pine, but does better in drier, harsher climates. Cones average 6-7" long.



Dwarf Scotch (Pinus sylvestris 'Glauca Nana')

Slow growing. Height 6', 6' wide. Eventually becomes a flattened globe form. An attractive, blue-green needles. Requires candle pruning to maintain a round form. Zone 3.



Crimson Pygmy (Berberis thunbergii 'Crimson Pygmy')

Full to part sun. Height 18-24", 30" wide. Select miniature form. Mature leaves are a bronzy bright red. New leaves bright red. Must have sun to develop color. Deciduous.



Virginia Creeper (Parthenocisus quinquefolia)

Big, vigorous vine that clings or runs over ground, fences, trellis. Leaves divide into five separate 6" leaflets with saw-toothed edges. Superb and dependable fall leaf color.



Japanese or Cuspidata (Taxus cuspidata)

Shade to part sun. Height 4', 6-8' wide. The arching branches create a vase shape. Deep green needle-like leaves, bright red fleshy fruit. Dense bush. Evergreen. *Can be trimmed.*



Alaska Blue or Purple Osier (Salix purpurea 'Nana')

Sun to shade. Height 3-4', 3-6' wide. Upright, rounded growth. Bluish, fine textured leaves in summer. Twigs purplish in winter. Very hardy. Deciduous. *Makes an attractive hedge*.



Snowmound (Spiraea nipponica)

Sun to part sun. Height 3', 4-5' wide. Compact, spreading habit. White flowers in round clusters along the stem in spring. Dense foliage of small blue green leaves. Deciduous.



Gro Low (Rhus aromatica 'Gro Lo')

Full sun to part shade. Height 2-3', 6-8' wide. Glossy trifoliate leaves. Yellow catking like flower in spring. Red fruit holds well into winter.



Royal Purple (Cotinus coggygria 'Royal Purple')

Full sun to part sun. Height 8-10', 8-10' wide. Upright, spreading form. Long-lasting pinkish-purple loose clusters of flowers look like puffs of smoke. Purple foliage holds color all summer, turning scarlet in fall. Deciduous.



Renaissance (Spiraea x vanhouttei 'Renaissance')

Sun to part sun. Height 5', 6' wide. Fountain shape. An improved Bridal Wreath. Arching boughs of blossoms in mid to late spring. Shape makes ideal specimen or dark green background shrub which turns orange-red in the fall. Tolerates wide range of soil conditions and is very cold hardy. Popular cut flower for wreath making. Deciduous.



Neon Flash (Spiraea japonica 'Neon Flash')

Sun to part sun. Height 3', 3' wide. Dense, mounding form. Flowers are bright red reoccurring over an extended season from late spring into early fall. New growth is tinted purple turning to green as it ages. Entire plant becomes dark burgundy with cold in autumn. Incredible color in both foliage and flowers. High tolerance for snow damage. Deciduous.



Moonlight (Cytisus scoparius 'Moonlight')

Sun to part sun. Height 5-6', 5-6' wide. Dense, mounding habit. 'Moonlight' yellow flowers in late spring. Deciduous.



Ramapo (Rhododendron 'Ramapo')

Shade to part shade. Height 3-4', 3-4' wide. Globe shaped mound. Outstanding compact habit holds plentiful pale violet blooms. Blooms early in season. Evergreen. *Need to acidify the soil in our area.*



Cheyenne (Ligustrum vulgare 'Cheyenne')

Full to part sun. Height 8-10', 5-6' wide. Upright form. White flowers in early to mid summer. Glossy deep green foliage. One of the hardiest privets. Deciduous. *Requires little water once established. Useful for hedging.*



Gold Star (Potentilla fruticosa 'Gold Star')

Sun to part sun. Height 2', 3' wide. Low, dense branching. In summer, a display of 2" wide golden-yellow blooms. Covered by rich green leaves. Deciduous.




Fraser's (Photinia fraseri)

Partial shade to shade. Height 6', 6' wide. Upright, rounded form. New growth appears bronze-red. Excellent hedge, screen or small tree. Can take some shearing. Evergreen. *Plant in a protected spot. Protect from winds.* Tree form available.



Gold Finger (Potentilla fruticosa 'Gold Finger')

Sun to part sun. HEight 3', 4' wide. Broadly branching mound. Golden yellow buttercuplike flowers in spring and summer. Deciduous



Western (Prunus besseyi)

Sun to part sun. Height 5-6', 5-6' wide. Rounded form. White, single flowers in May. $\frac{3}{4}$ " purple-black sweet fruits used for preserves. Prefers well drained sites. Silvery-green foliage turns purple in fall. Deciduous.
